

## San Jacinto Pilot Club Scholarship Guidelines For High School Applicants

**All scholarships given to high school seniors by the San Jacinto Pilot Club will be based on the following criteria:**

- Financial need will be a major factor. Priority will be given to Texas schools.
- High academic achievement is not mandatory; however, academic determination will be essential.
- Funds will be sent directly to the Financial Aid Office of the college or university of choice for disbursement.
- All applications must be postmarked no later than April 10, 2020.
- Recipients may reapply in subsequent years.

**All of the items listed below must accompany the application and be mailed to the San Jacinto Pilot Club:**

- Three (3) reference letters from adults outside the applicant's family (high school principal, counselors, teachers, neighbors, minister, business/community leaders, employers, etc.).
- A personal statement including educational background, extra-curricular activities, the applicant's chosen field of study, why this choice was made and what their goals are for the future.
- A copy of the applicant's high school/college (for dual credit) transcript.
- A list of the applicant's service and school activities.
- Must have a demonstrated financial need. Parent and applicants are required to submit the first two pages of the most recent IRS tax form for verification of need. **Please mark out the Social Security number(s) on all forms.**

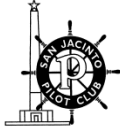
